



We at Faith want to help grow kids in their relationship with Christ. To that end, we're contributing \$150 toward an approved Christian Camp for students from Faith Baptist Church who complete the requirements below.

Complete at least 1 activity from each of the 5 tracks between February and April

GET INVOLVED

- Sunday School: Attend 8 Sunday school classes.
- Youth Group: Attend youth group 6 times.
- Bible Study: Attend 6 small group Bible studies.

MEMORIZE

- Memorize 13 individual verses.** These can be verses from church or school or verses that have been approved by Scholarship staff.
- Memorize a passage of at least 8 verses.** (*The same rules apply from above.*)

LEARN

- Sermon Notes:** Complete and hand in sermon notes for 8 weeks.
- Bible Application:** Read one of the books of the Bible listed on the back and write a 1-page report.

READ

- Daily Devotional:** Use a devotional book, magazine, or Bible reading plan and study the Bible for 8 weeks.
- Book Report:** Read a non-fiction Christian book. Write a 1-page report.

REACH OUT

- Visitation:** Visit a shut-in for an hour or help someone in need (without payment).
- Prayer Record:** Pray for others every day for 8 weeks.
- Leadership:** Teach a Bible lesson to a group, help in Awana or children's church 4 times, or help in nursery 2 times.
- Evangelism:** Bring a friend to church or youth group or volunteer at a local food pantry or shelter.
- Service:** Do a service project that takes at least 2 hours.

PARENTS: When work is completed and you've chosen a camp, **submit a payment form.** Checks will be mailed in early May.

MORE DETAILS

GET INVOLVED:

Attendance: Attendance needs to take place during the Scholarship period. Have your teacher or Awana leaders sign the Attendance Form and turn it in at the end of the Scholarship period (or once you've attended the required number.)

MEMORIZE:

Memorization: Verses or passages need to be approved by the Camp Scholarship staff before memorizing them. Verses must be recited to Camp Scholarship staff. A passage is several verses in a row up to a whole chapter, and needs to be recited in order.

LEARN:

Sermon Notes: Forms are available at the Camp Scholarship Program table or outside the sanctuary. Up to 3 sermons can be recorded sermons from FBC or another church, or a visit to another church.

Bible Study: Read and study one of the following listed books of the Bible. Write a 1-page report discussing 5 points from the book and how they apply to you.

READ:

Daily Devotional: Use a devotional book or magazine or your own Bible reading plan for 8 weeks (5 days per week) and either fill out the Devotional Forms for each week or bring in a devotional journal with dates for each day.

Book Report: Read a non-fiction Christian book. Write a 1-page report discussing 5 issues covered by the book, how they apply to you, and how you can use them in your daily life.

REACH OUT:

Visitation: Visit a shut-in for an hour or help someone in need (without payment). Write a 1-page report about the person, their faith background, something unique about them, and what you learned about yourself from the visit.

Prayer: Pray for others daily for 8 weeks. Try to pray for specific needs this person has. Fill out the Prayer Form showing who you prayed for on each date. Write a 1-2 paragraph report on how God answered and what you learned.

Leadership: Teach a Bible lesson to a group. Write a 1-page summary of what you taught and what you learned. Have a leader sign your summary to verify. **OR** Help in Awana or children's church 4 times. Have a leader sign the form verifying the dates you served. **OR** Help in nursery 2 times. Have a leader sign the form verifying the dates you served.
Note: These all need to be completed during camp scholarship time period.

Evangelism: Bring a friend to church, youth group, or another outreach event. Write a paragraph telling who you invited, where, and what the outcome was. **OR** Volunteer at the Albany or Schenectady City Mission, Regional Food Bank, or the FBC Food Pantry. Write a 1-page report on what you did and why it matters.

Service: Complete a service project after having it approved by Camp Scholarship Staff. It should be something that takes at least 2 hours. Write a 1-page report of what you did and why it was important.
