

Her life experiences have led her to a close, personal relationship with Christ. This transformation allows her to walk beside Beacon of Light volunteers and families, shining light in the darkness and bringing hope to others as they grow God's Kingdom together.

Youth Ministry

Faith partners with the student based ministry, Capital District Youth For Christ (CDYFC) by supporting the Executive Director, Andy Lightcap. Church planting in the Unreached parts of the world

The Timothy Initiative partners with local leaders in some of the least reached areas of the world to train disciples makers and church planters. 41% of the world, more than three billion people, live in areas with few Bibles, Christians, churches, or people trying to reach them. 84% of TTI efforts and resources are devoted to these areas. TTI believes the best way to fulfill the Great Commission is by making disciples who make disciples and planting churches that plant churches. Through training, local leaders equip Christians with the necessary tools, resources, and strategies to reach their nations for Christ. These churches meet in homes, on mountaintops, under trees, and in river beds. TTI does not focus on building structures, so it is sustainable, reproducible, and cost-effective.
